Economic Impact Study	Ed gave out a copy of the study to all. He will distribute it to the appropriate legislators. The study confirms the Race Industry has a billion dollar impact in Louisiana. Other than Kentucky, Louisiana GDP % is greater than other states. The calculation is very conservative. Dr. Terrell did an outstanding study.
